## ADVANCE NOTICE OF RACE

### NOTICE OF REGATTA

The Dragon Class South Coast Championship 2020 will be hosted by the Royal Cork Yacht Club in conjunction with Cork Week 2020. Racing will take place in and around Cork Harbour from July 15th to July 17th 2020. The Organising Authority (OA) for the event, by permission of the International Dragon Class Association, shall be the Royal Cork Yacht Club.



### 1. RULES

Racing will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020 (RRS), the Irish Sailing Association Prescriptions, and the international Dragon Class Rules.

### 2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This event will be open to boats and crews meeting the requirements of the International Dragon Class Rules.

### 5. SCHEDULE

Registration will be available at the Regatta Race Office from Saturday July 7th 2020.

Racing is scheduled from Wednesday July 15th 2020 to Friday July 17th 2020.

A varied and entertaining social program will be provided ashore, as part of Cork Week 2020.

### 6. NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Notice of Race will be posted online by early 2020, and the sailing instructions will be available in June 2020.

### 7. BERTHING

Complimentary berthing at the Royal Cork Yacht Club will be provided to all competitors during the event. When berthed, boats shall be kept in their assigned places.

### 8. LAUNCH AND RECOVERY

Free launch and recovery will be provided by the OA to competing boats.

### 9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk.

See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The OA will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### 10. INSURANCE

All boats shall be adequately insured against any risk, including civil responsibility to third parties, and to ensure that such insurance remains valid for the entirety of the boats attendance at the event.

### 11. MEDIA WAIVER

Competitors give their consent to the Royal Cork Yacht Club, its sponsors, and the OA to use their name, comments, photograph and likeness in order to promote the event.
