1720s

- Identification numbers provided by the OA must be displayed on the bow
- Poles must not be extended on the windward leg
- The 1720 Class Flag will be flown at the Warning Signal

- Fleet C will sail on the harbour course on Tuesday (See Section HC)

Marks

- Volvo 4 will be a large yellow inflatable mark

Beaufort Cup

- Competitors are asked to record their rounding times at the Fastnet Rock

Section OD - 1720s

OD 1.2 is DELETED and REPLACED by:

1.2 For the 1720 class;

- 1.2.1 Three races are scheduled on Monday 11th, Tuesday 12th, and Thursday 14th, with two races scheduled on Friday 15th July.
- 1.2.2 Identification numbers supplied by the OA shall be displayed on each bow. [DP]
- 1.2.3 Bowsprits shall be fully retracted at all times except when the gennaker is being set, is set, or is being retrieved. An extended bowsprit not complying with this instruction will not be considered as equipment in its normal position. At the windward mark the bowsprit shall not be extended before the bow crosses the extension of the line from the previous mark through the windward mark.

Note that the 1720 Class Flag will be used on the Committee Vessel (in place of the previously advised ICF "K") for relevant race signals. See also SI 6.4

BC 4.3 is INSERTED to read:

ROUNDING TIME

- 4.3 All Beaufort Cup yachts are requested to note their time of passing the Fastnet Rock. The time, the boat ahead, and the boat behind, should be recorded when the Fastnet Rock Lighthouse bears 090 degrees magnetic. (Ensure your time is synchronised with GPS/IST)
