Volvo Cork Week 2022 – Sailing Instructions

Amendment #4

Summary changes

- The time limits for the harbour course have been made more flexible
- The starting order of the 1720s and Dragons on the OD course may vary
- Volvo 4 is now a YELLOW CANONICAL mark
- The Warning Signal for the Inshore Classics on Thursday 14th July will be at 0955hrs

Amendments

SI 10.6 is DELETED and REPLACED by:

10.6 The time limit for each class in a Harbour race shall be one hour after the finish time of the first finisher in that class.

For Section OD – 1720 / Dragon course only:

The racing schedule is amended such that the starting order of the classes involved may vary for all races.

On Thursday 14th July 2022, up to four races may be sailed.

This amends Section OD 1.
